## Regional Alentejano Wine

### Red 2006

The vineyard of Monte do Pintor is located on a gentle hillside facing south. The main varieties, Trincadeira and Aragonez are typical for Alentejo and together give the wine a particular personality influenced by the characteristic soil possessing an unmistakable "Terroir".

### Vinification Process

Once the grapes have been harvested by hand they are destemmed and crushed, after this, the wine is then vinified with complete tanning in stainless steel vats (maceration of 10 to 15 days) in controlled temperature. Aging period of 6 months in French oak casks and a minimum of 8 months in bottle prior to market release.

### Tasting Notes

A deep garnet red color and fine aroma, persistent and complex, where very ripe fruits are distinctive.

The flavor is solid and reveals the same complexity and youth, manifested by slight acidulous. Pointing to a great longevity and an even greater expression, as result of fine tannins present in this wine.
